Report to School Council November 19, 2019

1. Ski Program (and alternate school program Gr. 1-3)

HAS is working with Pass PowderKeg to once again offer 4 days of skiing (including lessons) to Gr. 1-3 students. Dates: Jan 16, 23, 30 and Feb. 6. Alternate outdoor programming with Ms. Dembicki will be provided to students not participating in the ski program. Information packages have gone home to families. Payment needs to be received before students can ski. Applications for Kids Sport are available for any family requiring financial assistance.

2. Outdoor Classroom update

Kevin Eidick, manager of Landscape Architecture Invistec Consulting Ltd from Edmonton spent 2 days at HAS talking to staff and students about help he can provide to support the development of the outdoor learning space. He will be developing a site plan, which will allow the school to apply for grants for specific areas.

In addition, our playground equipment no longer meets code. The company that it was purchased from is no longer in business so parts for repairs are no longer available. No date has been provided for its removal, but it is likely that it will be dismantled by the end of this school year. It has been recommended by division office maintenance that if fundraising occurs for new equipment that we look at Blue Imp out of Medicine Hat.

3. Winter Concert - Dec. 19 @ 6:30 pm. ' Rock the Holidays!' A spring family event will be planned for April 8, 2020.

4. 12 Days of Giving - each year, HAS collects donations for the CNP Food Bank in the spirit of giving back to the community.

5. Retirement - Leslie Foster - custodian will be retiring on December 13, 2019 after years of service with LRSD. Leslie will be missed by students, staff and families! Shirley Graham will begin December 16, 2019 as the school's new custodian.

6. Budget 2019-20 -budget numbers have been received at the school level. All staffing (both teachers and support staff) positions are allocated from division office based on enrollment and student need. Costs associated with any additional staff beyond what has been allocated will come out of the school budget. Submitted budget numbers will be shared at the next school council meeting.

7. Student Teachers - PS1 students teachers have arrived and are busy in 1A, 2A and 2B and have quickly become part of our school. They will be here daily until December 12. Miss Breckenridge is in 1A with Mrs. Fast; Miss Hochstein is in 2A with Mrs. Tarcon and Mr. McDougall is in 2B with Mrs. Margetak.

8. One Book, Five Schools- In partnership with the Literacy Foundation, and with financial support from TransCanada, books have been ordered for the 6th annual family reading event. More details will become available in mid-January, and the title will be revealed at the start of the event in late January. This year 820 copies of one title will be distributed to families from the three CNP schools, and Livingstone, Canyon, and St. Mike's schools.
