## PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

- Children must be at least 3 years old on or before December 31, 2025.
- Children are encouraged to be fully toilet trained with some exceptions made for children with identified developmental delays or medical needs. Please contact the school to discuss further.
- Programming is available for children accessing Program Unit Funding (PUF) or mild to moderate support.

## 2025-2026 PROGRAM SCHEDULE OPTIONS & MONTHLY FEES

### 2 HALF-DAYS (3 hours/day)

#### At no cost choose from:

- MON/WED mornings
- MON/WED afternoons
- TUE/THU mornings
- TUE/THU afternoons

### 4 HALF-DAYS (3 hours/day)

#### For \$75/month choose from:

- MON-THU mornings
- MON-THU afternoons

**\$175/month =  
only \$75 with  
the Affordability  
Grant!**

Minimum number of registrations are required for each program. After registration we will contact you to confirm your registration and space availability in the program option that you have chosen. The program will follow the school calendar. Bussing is not available for the Early Learning Program.

Fees reflect Livingstone Range School Division's participation in the Canada-Alberta Early Learning and Child Care Agreement. \$100/month will be reduced off parent fees through the Affordability Grant.

## PROGRAM SUPPORTS & DEVELOPMENTAL NEEDS

Programming is overseen by a Certified Teacher. Children who may require additional support have access to a speech and language pathologist, occupational therapist, physiotherapist or other members of the Livingstone Range School Division Learning Services Team.
